## ***GAVC Welding Program***

This course is designed for students who are planning on a career in either production or job shop industrial welding. The main objective is to acquire the skills and the knowledge necessary to enter industry as a beginning welder. Much time will be spent in the welding lab. The course will include stick arc welding, mig welding, tig welding, plasma cutting, cutting torches, brazing, braze welding, submerged arc, blue prints, and shop safety. Students will receive college credit in addition to high school credit. Some use of personal transportation may be needed.



**JOB OUTLOOK:** Employment for welders and fabricators in construction is expected to increase faster than average for all occupations through the year 2020. Job prospects are expected to be excellent for skilled welders and fabricators. Salary opportunities are excellent.



**BONUS:** Earn college credit for skills learned at Galesburg Area Vocational Center. Successful completion of the Welding program will earn a minimum of thirteen hours of college credit at Carl Sandburg College. This coordinated curriculum eliminates duplication of coursework.
